

## Local Transport Information

The University is about a kilometre (uphill) from the city centre and hotels and is on several bus and tram routes.

In Sheffield the buses are run by two companies (First and Stagecoach). Stagecoach also runs the tram (Supertram). Tickets for one company, bus route or tram are not in general valid on another.

First Buses **51** and **52** run every few minutes from the city centre (High Street) to the University and Stagecoach **52** also runs on the same route *during the day only*; fares are from 85p to £1.30 – pay the driver. The tram from the Cathedral stop (directions Malin Bridge (Blue line) and Middlewood (Yellow line) is frequent and costs £1.20 for a single journey (pay conductor on board).

The tram (Blue route – direction Halfway) also runs from the University directly to the stop at the back of the Railway Station, at intervals of ~15 minutes, and taking 15+ minutes (also £1.20 per single journey). At most times of day, the tram route will be faster than taking a taxi to the station.

You may find it worth buying an All Day Bus and Tram ticket (useable on tram and Stagecoach buses only) for £3.50 – obtained from driver/conductor – valid till midnight on the day of purchase. There is also a 7-day version (Mega Rider) at £14.50.
